I, _____, desire to work as a volunteer for Run Nova Scotia (RNS) and engage in the activities related to being a volunteer for road running and event expos.

I hereby freely and voluntarily, without duress, execute this Waiver under the following terms:

1. Waiver and Release.

I, the Volunteer, release and forever discharge and hold harmless Run Nova Scotia and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from my volunteer work with Run Nova Scotia.

I understand and acknowledge that this Waiver discharges Run Nova Scotia from any liability or claim that I, the Volunteer, may have against the organization with respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from my participation on the event site. I also understand that Run Nova Scotia does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health or disability insurance, in the event of injury, illness, death or property damage.

2. Insurance.

I, the Volunteer, understand that I expressly waive any such claim for compensation or liability on the part of Run Nova Scotia beyond what may be offered freely by the representative of Run Nova Scotia in the event of such injury or medical expense.

3. Medical Treatment.

I hereby release and forever discharge Run Nova Scotia from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered in connection with an emergency during my time while volunteering.

4. Assumption of the Risk.

I understand that my time with Run Nova Scotia may include activities that may be hazardous to me, including, but not limited to, loading and unloading of equipment and materials. I hereby expressly and specifically assume the risk of injury or harm in these activities and release Run Nova Scotia from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from the activities of my time with the organization.

5. Photographic Release.

I grant and convey unto Run Nova Scotia all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by the organization during my volunteering, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.

6. Other.

I expressly agree that this Waiver is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the Province of Nova Scotia, and that this Waiver shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the law. I agree that in the event that any clause or provision of this Waiver shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.
